The Modern Kissing Game

In today's modern weddings, people have been getting creative in coming up with new fun ways to get the bride and groom to kiss. There is of course always the traditional clinking of the glasses, but here are some other fun ideas.

Have your guests perform some sort of trick or talent. This could be anything, for example requiring guests to sing part of a love song, or having them use a hoola-hoop, or answering trivia questions about the couple. The questions are placed at their tables ahead of time.



If the Shoe Fits

This game is an crowd favourite. The game is wildly entertaining and amazingly simple, usually done soon after dinner.

The bride and groom sit back to back on chairs in the middle of the room where all can see. They remove their shoes and exchange one shoe each. The MC or DJ will ask pre-planned questions of the couple. The questions can be as wild or as tame as you like. The bride and groom answer the questions using the shoe that fits. It always gets a laugh from the crowd.



Take My Hand

This game keeps the crowd entertained as they watch the bride and/or groom blindly trying to guess who their partner is.

Choose 5-6 guests, if choosing for the groom select ladies and choose men for the bride. Have them sit in a line of chairs. The brave participants must hold out their hand while the bride and/or groom try locating their partner while blindfolded, simply by the touch of the hand. A sweet game with a humorous hint of danger...



Musical Chairs

A childhood favourite, it brings out the inner child in any adult wedding guest! Gather a bunch of chairs and bring them to the dance floor. Remember to have one chair less than you do people. The group circles the chairs until the music stops and they try to find a seat. The person left standing must leave and take a chair with them. Repeat this until there is one winner and give them a small prize!

Pass the Buck

If you feel your guests might enjoy something to get them up and switch into party gear just before the dance floor, try this game. The MC or DJ asks only one person at each table to take out some money, and hold it up. The DJ plays music and the money passes around the table. When the music stops, the person holding the money must come up and dance to a song of the DJ's choice. They head back to their table. The trick is, it's not them who have won the centerpiece. It's the person who gave out the money! Always a laugh!

Stickers on Chair Bottoms

Other than the guest with the Closest Birthday to the wedding date, Stickers on Chair Bottoms is the simplest centerpiece giveaway. People sit down randomly and win randomly.
